



Medication Consent

Parent/ Legal Guardian consent and agreement to First Aid, Emergency and Medical Examination. Our nursery is fully covered by public liability insurance.

Consent for the use of the following topical creams:

- Bepanthen cream for broken skin
- Arnica cream for bumps and bruises
- Fenistil cream for insect bites
- Bactroban cream for larger scrapes

Consent for annual Medical examination by the designated nursery Doctor;

According to the Ministry of Social Affairs guidelines, children require a medical examination by the designated Nursery Doctor in the presence of the nursery school nurse once per year. As parents, you will be notified prior to any examination-taking place and will be given the opportunity to attend.

Consent for the administration of 'over the counter' medicine (e.g: Calpol and Anti-Histamine medication)

In the event that your child develops a fever, or has pain, or a mild allergic reaction, it may be necessary to administer Calpol syrup (pain/ fever reliever) or Claritine (anti-histamine) syrup. If your child is unable to take this medication, please contact the nursery school Nurse to discuss an alternative medication. You will always be contacted by phone prior to administration, however the Nurse may have to administer medication without prior verbal consent if we are unable to contact you.
